INFORMATION, ENTRY FEES, RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

Entry Fees: Please note that <u>classes must be entered with the Show Secretary and entry fees paid</u> before commencement of class. Entries should be made on the forms provided and handed to the Show Secretary with your entry fees. Entries will be taken from 9:15 a.m. on both days. It would help if you could complete the Entry Form attached to the schedule in advance and hand this in on the day.

Please try and enter as early as possible to avoid the queues! If you are intending to compete in the first three classes of the day please enter at least 15 minutes before the commencement of the show in order for the Show Secretary to prepare sheets for the Judges.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry into the ring if fees have not been paid.

Refunds will only be made if the class is cancelled by the Organisers.

Class Timings: Shows will start promptly at time stated. Class timings thereafter are to be read as NOT BEFORE stated time in this schedule.

Sunday 27th August: - Showing Show 10:00 a.m. start Classes will follow-on unless specified.

Ridden Classes (all-weather arena)

Not before 11:30 am

Working Hunter Classes (on grass)

Monday 28th August - Show Jumping ONLY (all weather arena) 10:00 a.m. start

Class 27 – Mini Clear Round jumping will start promptly at 10:00 a.m.

Class 29 - Not before 11:00 a.m. - all other classes will follow on.

Catering: There are hot and cold drinks and snacks vending machines on site, but competitors are advised to bring their own lunch.

Rules

- a) ALL Exhibitors competing in the Showing Show (27th August) will be issued with a number. Please collect your number from the Show Secretary on arrival at the show.
- b) All riders and handlers must be correctly dressed when in the ring. British Standard hard hats must be worn with chinstrap fastened when mounted anywhere on HFEC premises. NO Beaglers or Bowlers to be worn in any ridden class.
- c) <u>Tack:</u> Competitors are expected to present their horse / pony in appropriate tack. Martingales, flash and drop nosebands are not permitted in flat ridden classes.
- d) The Organisers do not accept responsibility for loss, damage or injury to competitors or spectators or their property or animal in connection with any event.

- e) Appropriate footwear should be worn by anyone handling or in charge of animals. Sandals / trainers are not deemed appropriate footwear. The organisers accept no responsibility as set out in d) above.
- f) Competitors are responsible for getting themselves to the ring in time for their class.
- g) Stallions are welcome but must be 'bitted' at all times and display a 'stallion disk' on their bridle and be under the supervision of a competent handler / rider.
- h) The Judge's decision is final.
- i) All competitors age is as at 1st January in current year.
- j) Ridden horses / ponies must be 4 years old and over.
- k) Horses / ponies must not be left tied up outside their trailer or horsebox unsupervised.
- I) **Amalgamation of classes:** The organisers reserve the right to amalgamate ridden classes if there are less than 3 entries.
- m) <u>In Hand Classes</u>: All ponies/horses should be shown 'bitted' and in a bridle (with the exception of Yearlings).
- n) Lead Rein class: Rider must not compete off the Lead Rein in any other class.
- o) **HFRC Members**: Members should carry their membership card with them whilst competing as this may be required by the Judge (or Steward).
- p) **Pony Classes**: Ponies up to and including 14.2 hh / 148 cms. Riders any age but must be suitable size for mount.
- q) Horses: Horses exceeding 14.2 hh/153 cms. Riders any age.
- r) <u>Mountain & Moorland</u>: Riders any age. Classes will be split Small and Large Breeds as specified in schedule.
- s) Working Hunter Classes:

Novice Working Hunter Pony or Horse: NOT to have won £25 in any WH class

Ponies: Novice WHP: Fence height: 50 cms max (not exc. 13 hh)

65 cms max (exc. 13 hh).

Open WHP: Fence height: 65 cms max 13 hh & under.

70 cms to 85 cms max exc. 13 hh

Horses: Novice WHH: Fence height: 75 cms max.

Open WHH: Fence height: 80 cms to 90 cms max.

M & M: Small Breeds (up to 13.2 hh): Fence height 60 cms

Large Breeds (exc. 13.2 hh): Fence height 75 cms max.

- t. Novice Show Jumping: Horse or Pony not to have won more than £25 in any SJ classes.
- u. <u>Veteran</u>: Horse / Pony 15 yrs. & over. Rider must be correct weight and height for mount. No galloping or spurs.
- v. RESTRICTED RIDDEN SHOWING CLASS FOR HOLME FARM HORSE & PONIES: Open to Holme Farm horses/ponies ONLY. To be judged on 50% turn-out and 50% on short ridden display. Rider combination **NOT** to have competed away from yard.
- w. <u>Best Turned Out</u>: To be judged in natural state, plaited or hogged. Separate prizes will be awarded to a) BTO Natural state b) BTO trimmed, plaited or hogged.
- x. <u>Best Ridden Show Cob, Horse or Hunter</u>: Horses may only compete in **one** of the Best Ridden classes 17, 18 or 19.
- y. **Show Cobs** to be shown hogged and trimmed. Horses exc. 148 cms (14.2 hh) and not exc. 155 cms (15.1 hh)

- 6. Best Veteran 15 yrs. and over (Special prize for best exhibit over 20 yrs.)

Ridden Classes (all weather arena)

To follow on - not before 11:30 am

Classes may be amalgamated if less than 3 entries or split if more than 10 entries

- 8. Best turned-out lead rein (7 yrs. and under)
- 9. Best turned-out pony not exc. 14.2 hh /148 cms.
- 10. Best turned out horse exc. 14.2 hh / 148 cms. To be judged in natural state, trimmed, plaited or hogged. Separate prizes will be awarded
 - a) BTO Natural state
 - b) b) BTO trimmed.
- 11. Best ridden lead rein
- 12. Best ridden pony not exc. 14.2 hh / 148 cms
- 13. Best ridden coloured
- 14. Best ridden Mountain and Moorland must be shown in natural state. **Will split Small Breeds** and Large breeds if over 10 entries.
- 15. Holme Farm Restricted Class for Best Ridden Horse or Pony. See Rules
- 16. Best Ridden Veteran horse or pony (15 yrs. and over)

Horses may only compete in one of the following classes 17, 18 & 19

- 17. Best Ridden Show Cob. To be shown hogged and trimmed. Horses exc. 14.2 hh / 148 cms and not exc. 15.1 hh / 155 cms.
- 18. Best Ridden Hunter (exc. 14.2 hh / 148 cms). To be shown plaited and trimmed.
- 19. Best Ridden Horse (exc. 14.2 hh / 148 cms). To be shown plaited and trimmed.

Entry fees must be paid before commencement of class (or entering the ring).

Ponies: Not exc. 14.2 hh/148 cms. Rider any age but must be suitable size for mount.

Horses: Exc. 14.2 hh / 148 cms. Rider any age.

27. Clear Round Classes – commencing at 10:00 a.m.

27a Mini Clear Round27b Clear Round

28. Lead Rein Jumping 7 yrs. and under. Must not compete off-lead rein in any other class.

Class 29 will not commence before 11:00 a.m.

- 29. **Beginner Pony** (not exc. 14.2 hh/148 cms) Pony and rider never to have won any show jumping class. Fence height 55 cms.
- 30. **Novice Pony** (not exc. 14.2 hh/148 cms) Pony not to have won £25 or more show jumping. Fence height 60 cms.
- 31. **Beginner Horse** (exc. 14.2 hh/148 cms). Horse and rider never to have won any class show jumping class (home or away). Fence height 60 cms
- 32. **Pairs** (open to horses and ponies). Fence height 55 cms
- 33. Intermediate Pony (not exc. 14.2 hh / 148 cms). Fence height 75 cms
- 34. Open Pony (not exc. 14.2 hh / 148 cms) Fence height 85 cms.
- 35. **Novice Horse** (exc. 14.2 hh / 148 cms): Horse not to have won £25 or more in any show jumping class. Fence height 70 cms.
- 36. Intermediate Horse (exc. 14.2 hh / 148 cms): Fence height 80 cms
- 37. Open Horse (exc. 14.2 hh / 148 cms): Fence height up to 90 cms
- 38. **Top Score:** Open to both horses and ponies. Prizes 1st £10, 2nd £7, 3rd £5. Minimum of 5 entries to run class.
