1. Youngstock 1- 3 years. (*Colt, filly or gelding*)
2. Young Handler (10 yrs. and under)
3. Coloured
4. Mountain and Moorland & Traditional - must be shown in natural state. Class may be split if entries allow. Separate prizes for Small and Large breeds.
5. Open Pony 14.2 hh and under
6. Open Horse Exc. 14.2 hh
7. Veteran 15 yrs. and over (*Special prize for best exhibit over 20 yrs.*)
8. Best Condition Horse or Pony

**IN-HAND CHAMPIONSHIP: 1st & 2nd prize winners from
Classes 1 to 8 to compete**

Classes may be amalgamated if less than 3 entries or split if more than 10 entries

9. Tack and Turn-out. To be judged in natural state, trimmed, plaited or hogged. Separate prizes will be awarded for
 - a) Natural state
 - b) Trimmed/Plaited or hogged
10. Lead Rein – rider 7 yrs. and under. Rider not eligible to ride loose in any other class.
11. First Ridden – rider 10 yrs. and under. You will be asked to walk and trot as a ride but will not be required to canter. You may canter in your individual show if you want to.
12. Novice horse or pony – for genuine novice horses/ponies. To be judged in walk and trot – you may include canter in your individual show if you want to.
13. Ridden Pony (excl. M&M and Traditional) Not exc. 14.2 hh / 148 cms
14. Ridden Horse - 14.3 hh / 148 cms and over (excluding M&M and Traditional). Class may be split if entries allow into the following categories:
 - Show Cob (to be shown hogged and trimmed)
 - Hunter
 - Riding Horse
15. Beginner Showing – for genuine novice riders who have not won any Ridden Showing class, except Tack and Turnout. To be judged in walk and trot – you may canter in your individual show if you want to.
16. Ridden M&M and Traditional - to be shown in natural state. Will split Small and Large breeds if entries allow.
17. Ridden coloured
18. Veteran horse or pony (15 yrs. and over)

Please try and enter as early as possible. We would appreciate it if you could enter for Classes 1, 2 & 3 by 9:45 a.m. in order for the Show Secretary to prepare sheets for the Judge.

ALL Entry Fees must be paid before entering the ring.

RULES

1. Refunds of classes will only be made if the Organisers cancel the class.
2. Competitors are responsible for getting themselves to the ring in time for their class.
3. We reserve the right to amalgamate classes with few entries, or split large classes if necessary.
4. The Organisers do not accept responsibility for loss, damage or injury to competitors or spectators or their property or animal in connection with any event.
5. Stallions are welcome but must be 'bitted' at all times and display a 'stallion disk' on their bridle and be under the supervision of a competent handler / rider.
6. The Judge's decision is final.
7. All competitors age is as at 1st January in current year.
8. Ridden horses / ponies must be 4 years old and over.
9. Horses / ponies must not be left tied up outside their trailer or horsebox unsupervised.
10. **In Hand Classes:** All ponies/horses should be shown 'bitted' and in a bridle (with the exception of Yearlings).
11. **Lead Rein class:** Rider must not compete off the Lead Rein in any other class.
12. **Tack:** Competitors are expected to present their horse / pony in appropriate tack. Martingales are not permitted in any ridden class.
13. **Competitor Dress:** Correct dress must be worn by the competitor.
Hats with chin strap fastened must be worn whilst mounted, and by handlers 16 yrs. and under for all In Hand classes. Senior handlers are expected to wear an appropriate hat.
14. **Beginner Showing / Novice Horse/Pony:** These classes are for genuine novice rider or horse/pony and we expect competitors to enter into the spirit for which these classes are intended.
15. **Holme Farm Riding Club Members:** Get additional points for correct dress for your class.
