Entry Fees & Rules

ALL fees must be paid before the commencement of your class. Pre-entries must be paid for at time of booking. We will accept card, cheque or cash.

Entries will be taken on the day from 9:30 a.m. - Please try and enter as early as possible. If you wish to compete in classes 1 or 2 we would appreciate it if you could register/enter by 9:45 a.m.

GENERAL RULES:

- a) **Riding Club Members:** Membership Cards **MUST BE** presented at time of entry to benefit from Member Entry Rates, and must be signed following the completion of each class to get points.
- b) Adults riding ponies must be suitable weight/height for exhibit. Riders any age.
- c) Lead rein entries are not allowed to compete in any other class off the lead.
- d) Hats to current standard must be worn and chin strap fastened at all times whilst mounted. Skull riding hats with protective cover should be worn for Hunter Trial classes.
- e) Competitors age as at 1st January in current year.
- f) Horse/ponies must not be left tied up outside of their trailer or horsebox unsupervised.
- g) Any horse/pony behaving in an unfit or dangerous manner in either the collecting ring or in a class will be asked to leave.
- h) Approximate times for Classes will be posted on our Facebook Events page.
- i) **Competitor Dress:** Correct dress must be worn by the competitor
 - Long hair should be secured appropriately
 - **Jewellery** can increase the risk of injury - competitors are advised to remove all jewellery and piercings (excl. wedding bands).
 - **HUNTER-TRIAL:** Competitors should wear a sweater or shirt ideally with long sleeves, white, buff or fawn breeches and a body protector, or jacket with stock or tie.
 - **SHOWJUMPING:** Competitors should wear a black / navy or tweed jacket with a stock / tie, white, buff or fawn breeches/jodhpurs.

Rules, Scoring & Penalties

Classes will be run with a short-timed section. The fastest through the timed section and fewest penalties will be the winner.

All fences knock down. 10 penalties for a pole down. 15 penalties for a stop. We will try and get everyone round 😊.

The course will have a timed section. The rest of the course to be completed at a steady pace.

There will be an Option Fence within the course.

Riders will be stopped if they are considered dangerous.

Scoring and Penalties:

Timed section:

- No penalties for refusals or run outs.
- Exceeding the time allowed in the timed section will incur elimination.

Rest of the course: To be finished at a steady pace but penalties will be incurred:

- 10 penalties - knock down / fence lowered.
- 15 penalties - stop / refusals / run out.
- 3 refusals or more carry 100 penalties.

CLASS SCHEDULE

10:00 onwards: Hunter Trial (on grass Arena)

In the interests of horse/pony welfare you may only compete on the same horse/pony in **TWO** of the following classes.

Class

1. 30 cm - Lead Rein Rider 7 yrs. and under
2. 40 cm - 10 years and under
3. 40 cm
4. 50 cm
5. 50 cm – Pairs
6. 60 cm
7. 60 cm - Pairs
8. 70 cm
9. 80 cm

10:00 onwards CLEAR ROUND SHOW JUMPING (all weather arena)

Fences raised as class height increase (see above).
