Rules and further information:

Please enter in the true spirit of the competition. Classes 1 – 5 are for novice and less experienced competitors who have not previously competed at a higher level.

If you have extensive experience or an accomplished mount we now have a 70 cm Open Class.

The Cross Country is all knock down fences in an enclosed field, and there will be **no** eliminations. Our aim is to get you round the course.

Show Jumping and Dressage will be held on all-weather arenas.

Scoring and Penalties

Dressage: Penalties will be worked out on percentage penalties.

Show Jumping:

4 penalties - knock down.

4 penalties - stop.

4 penalties - lowered fence.

Elimination will carry 30 penalty points to next phase.

Cross Country:

10 penalties - knock down / fence lowered.

15 penalties - stop.

3 refusals or more and exceeding time allowed carry 100 penalties.

How to Enter

You can enter by telephone (01283 813284) and pay by card or send entries with payment to Holme Farm Equestrian Centre to arrive at the latest by **28th June***.

Entry Fees must be made at time of booking.

Refunds: 50% entry fee will be refunded if you cancel before the Closing Date. **No refunds** will be made after the Closing Date unless your slot is taken by a late entry.

If the event is cancelled by the Organisers all entry fees will be carried forward to future events or shows.

***Entries close Wednesday 28th June or before if class is full.**

Prizes: Trophies to winner Medals to 3rd place Beautiful rosettes to 10th

Catering: There are hot and cold drinks and snacks vending machines on site, but competitors are advised to bring their own lunch.

Rules:

- Classes and results may be divided into sections (Juniors and Seniors) dependent on number of entries.
- A change of tack is permitted between each phase.

- Snaffle bit required for Dressage test in classes 3 to 7.
- Any bridle is allowed for Dressage in both our Lead Rein and 10 yrs. and under 40 cm classes -1 and 2.
- Plaiting preferred in Dressage phase but not essential especially for Native and Traditional types.
- You may have a caller for your dressage test if you wish.
- Please try and find time to walk both the XC and SJ courses prior to competing.
- Body protectors **must be** worn for the XC phase.
- Hats must conform to current safety standards for each discipline.
- Skull riding hats with protective cover should be worn for XC phase.
- Lead rein entries are not allowed to compete in any other class off the lead.
- **Restricted Classes:** for competitors who have not successfully competed in OD events elsewhere.
- **Open Class:** for competitors with extensive experience or an accomplished horse/pony in ODE.
- **Competitor Dress Code:**
 - Long hair should be secured appropriately
 - **Jewellery** can increase the risk of injury - competitors are advised to remove all jewellery and piercings (excl. wedding bands).
 - **DRESSAGE:** Competitors should wear a black or dark blue jacket with a stock/tie or tweed coat with a stock/tie. White, buff or fawn breeches should be worn with gloves.
 - **SHOWJUMPING:** Competitors should wear a black / navy or tweed jacket with a stock / tie, white, buff or fawn breeches/jodhpurs.
 - **CROSS-COUNTRY:** Competitors should wear a sweater or shirt — ideally with long sleeves — white, buff or fawn breeches and a body protector. Alternatively, you can compete in the same attire as that worn for Dressage or Show Jumping.

CLASSES START PROMPTLY AT 10:00 a.m.

CLASS 1 – Lead rein* 35 cm **Dressage Test:** Intro C

CLASS 2 - 10 yrs. & Under* 40 cm **Dressage Test:** Intro C

Any size horse/pony, rider any age may compete in the following classes (see rules)

CLASS 3 – Beginners 40 cm **Dressage Test:** Intro C

CLASS 4 - Restricted 50 cm **Dressage Test:** Prelim 4

CLASS 5 - Restricted 60 cm **Dressage Test:** Prelim 4

CLASS 6 - Open 70 cm **Dressage Test:** Prelim 18

Schooling rounds will be available at the end of the day's competition.
